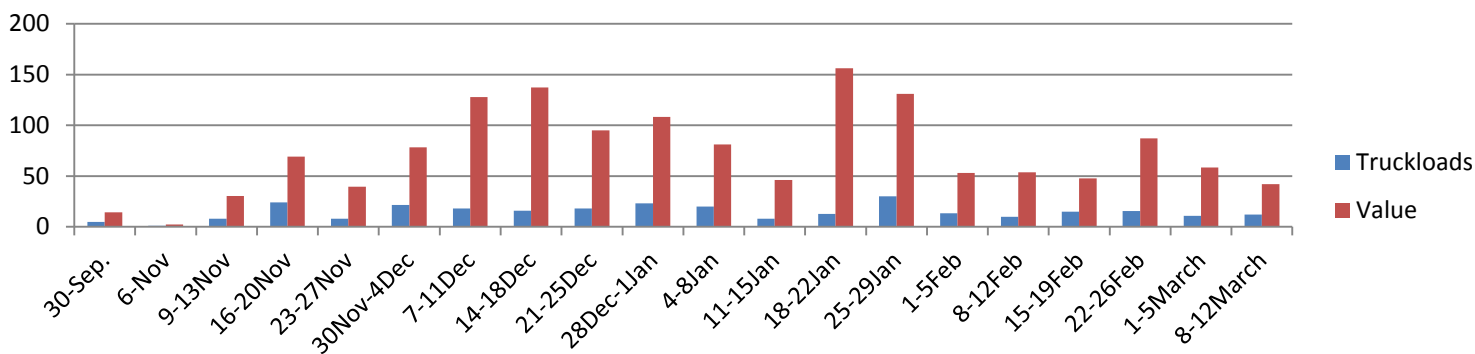

Weekly exports truckloads and value(000' USD)



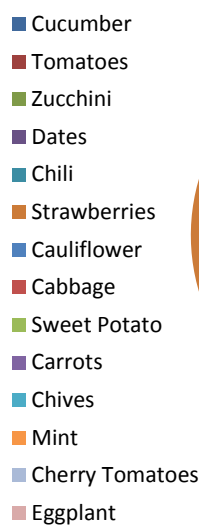
Exports to Israel

Exports to other destinations

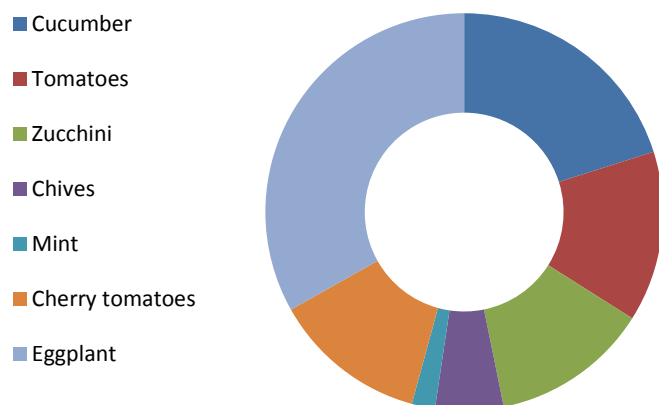

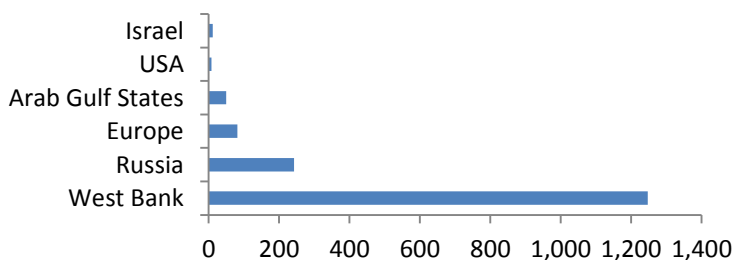
Total exports value by product since Sep.30 (%)



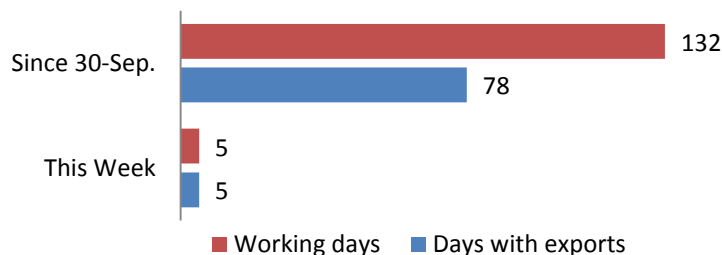
Weekly exports value by product (%)

Highlights

- Gaza produced eggplants and tomatoes were allowed into the Israeli markets for the first time since eight years on Thursday.
- Israeli authorities announced the willingness to receive 1,200 tons of agricultural crops per month from Gaza.
